All children benefitted from expert teaching from P.E. lessons through the year and specific tennis teaching in the summer term, including a trip to the local tennis centre. All children were provided with travel to The Blue School to participate in multi-schools sports activities every term. These activities would not have run without the fund as school would not have the available money and many parents would not be in the position to pay for all these activities.

A teacher was hired to take children from Y2 to Y6 swimming for half the academic year (and Y1 for ½ term). We believe swimming is an important life skill and this use of funding ensures that children in our school are able to learn to swim over an extended period of time.

For those children who are particularly interested in sport, the fund provided opportunities for all to participate rather than only those who could afford it. The fund paid for membership of the local cross country league and transport to the meets. It also subsidised the cost of after-school football and cricket clubs provided by a local company.
